

## **FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

Litigation over control of the Cheyenne Mountain companies' assets has been ongoing since February 2010. Dark Comet has been a peaceful observer in that litigation, cooperating with the court-appointed receiver of two of the Cheyenne Mountain companies to keep the Stargate Resistance game online. During the Summer of 2010, a small group of wealthy individuals claiming status as Cheyenne Mountain shareholders sought to take over Dark Comet's position. Dark Comet declined this group's terms. The group then hired two large law firms (one in Arizona and one in Missouri) to file suit against Dark Comet and others in August 2010. The group's forty-four page, nine count complaint was the basis for its request for a broad range of injunctive relief against Dark Comet. On August 25, 2010, following a hearing, Maricopa County Superior Court Judge Sam Myers denied each and every one of those requests. The group has decided to nonetheless continue with its lawsuit against Dark Comet. Dark Comet intends to vigorously defend.
